This week, despite the continued Government Shutdown, there was some important progress on the policy side of government and data. President Trump signed into law the Foundations for Evidence-Based Policy making (FEBP) Act ([H.R. 4174, S. 2046](#)) on Monday. The new law includes the **Open, Public, Electronic and Necessary (OPEN) Government Data Act (Title II)** and requires all non-sensitive government data to be made available in open and machine-readable formats by default. It establishes Chief Data Officers (CDO) at federal agencies, as well as a CDO Council. The White House's Statement included:

"The law's mission is to improve operational efficiencies and government services, reduce costs, increase public access to government information, and spur innovation and entrepreneurship. This is a win for evidence-based decision-making within the government."
